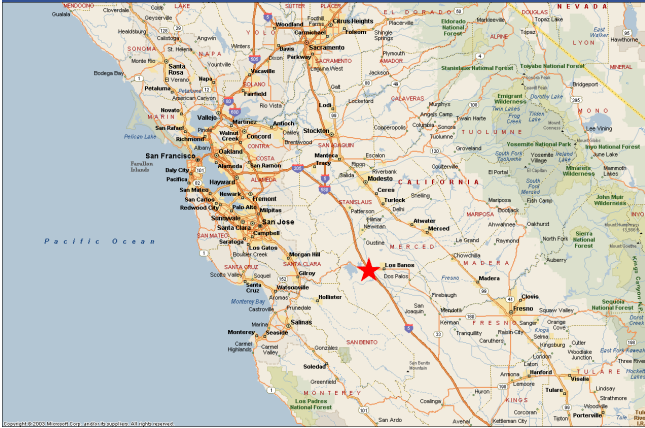

## ALERT SUMMARY: LOS BANOS TANKER TRUCK ACCIDENT

February 3, 2006

### INCIDENT SITUATION

A tractor trailer hauling 4000 gallons of hydroxylamine overturned on the I-5 transition to SR-152 on February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2006. Hydroxylamine is an ammonia-like substance that is corrosive and possibly explosive and is dangerous if inhaled or touched. 250-500 gallons of the chemical were spilled which required hazmat teams to respond for cleanup. Ten miles of I-5 was shut down in both directions for a day and a half and SR-152 was closed for an additional 24 hours.

### NC4 COVERAGE

NC4 provides ongoing updates to members as the incident unfolds through the National Incident Monitoring Center (NIMC). NIMC analysts follow the incident using official government sources as well as national and local media sources - linking to the CBS 13 local breaking article, *Interstate 5 Completely Shutdown at Santa Nella*, including images from the scene, eyewitness news video, and real time metro traffic conditions.

### Selected NIMC Updates:

CHP confirms the interstate is closed due to tanker truck accident and chemical spill. 2/3/06 13:17 PST

I-5 & SR-152 are both completely shut down in both directions. SB traffic being diverted to SR-140. 2/3/06 17:39 PST

I-5 & SR-152 expected to be closed in both directions throughout weekend. 2/3/06 18:55 PST

CHP reports that I-5 may reopen by this evening but that SR-152 will remain closed. 2/4/06 14:20 PST

Northbound and southbound lanes of I-5 have reopened; SR-152 remains closed. 2/4/06 18:42 PST

I-5 open, SR-152 expected to reopen on Monday. 2/5/06 13:08 PST

**Synopsis:** I-5 & SR-152 expected to be closed in both directions throughout weekend.

**What:** The California Highway Patrol is expecting I-5 to be completely shut down in both directions at SR-152 for the entire weekend due to a tanker truck accident and chemical spill. Hazmat teams are working to clean up an unspecified amount of Hydroxylamine Sulfate, a substance that is toxic if inhaled, ingested or touched. No injuries have been reported at this time. Cal trans has stated that the closure may last for more than one day. SR-152 is also shut down in both directions at the scene. [\[more...\]](#)
