NC4’s partnership with TranSecur gives members the most complete global coverage of risk and incident reporting available.

## Predictive intelligence

Unlike a clipping service that regurgitates what is readily available in newspapers or on TV, TranSecur collects, collates and analyzes global developments to produce predictive intelligence. TranSecur content is developed by trained intelligence analysts distinguished by their regional knowledge and language skills. Utilizing primary sources on the ground in the countries of interest – such as police, military personnel, diplomats, academics, journalists, medical personnel, and people engaged in a variety of service industries – analysts turn information into intelligence. In addition, TranSecur analysts maintain contact with U.S. and other friendly foreign embassy personnel, dealing as circumstances warrant with the Regional Security Officer, Defense Attaché, commercial offices, and others.

TranSecur analyzes global risk and conveys this information to members through the following web-based services:

**Daily Analytical Briefs** – Focusing on potential near-term risk, Daily Analytical Briefs provide original, predictive analyses that review and identify emerging risk situations. Written daily by TranSecur intelligence analysts using primary sources, members can rely on the briefs to tell them “what they need to know, before they know they need to know it”. Posted each morning at 9:00 AM EST, Daily Analytical Briefs put emphasis on the implications of global developments that affect traveler safety, security, health, capital assets, and convenience.

**Country Reports** – Focusing on the longer-term risk perspective, Country Reports include a risk assessment by country; city-level risks are identified as appropriate; and, the rationale for the assessment is provided (i.e. economic, political and related inputs are discussed). Country Reports are a valuable information source for security directors, corporate risk managers, human resource managers, travelers, travel offices, site selection committees and business planners. Authorized users can generate and distribute custom reports by selecting specific data fields pulled from the Country Reports – from health and safety, key contact numbers, and preferred hotels to crime and terrorism, economic conditions, and political developments – to aid the decision-making process about travel, dependent relocation, construction, and more.

**News at a Glance** – A summary of global developments, clients use News at a Glance to stay informed of world events that may affect corporate interests. A variety of primary and local sources provide a multi-dimensional view that members rely on to calculate travel security conditions around the world.

**Special Reports** – Analysis of scheduled events may require security preparation, such as the Olympic Games, World Bank/IMF meetings, Ryder Cup, Paris Air Show, World Cup Soccer, etc. TranSecur provides assessments of potential risks or other outcomes and recommended responses.

**Women’s Issues in Travel/Security** – TranSecur pioneered specialized attention to the growing number of women travelers more than a decade ago, providing analysis of gender-related security challenges and cultural issues confronting female executives operating internationally.

## Basic Subscription

The TranSecur Basic Subscription includes the above services and is provided to a single primary-use group within a corporation, such as a Security Office. While there is no limitation on the number of primary-use group personnel that can access the system, use is restricted to the primary-use group. The member-only area of the TranSecur website cannot be displayed on the corporate intranet or otherwise made available directly to personnel outside the primary-use group.

## Enterprise Solution

The TranSecur Enterprise Solution provides access to the above services and is provided to the entire corporation, typically through the primary-use group (i.e. Security Office). The information can be made accessible via the corporate intranet and TranSecur will brand the system so that it appears to be an organic offering of the primary-use group.
